



# **Problem Statement**

Housekeeping staff use printed paper as a checklist. The purpose of the checklist is to track work done in a designated area.



Number of areas where paper checklists are used today in one site are 14+. These sheets are replaced everyday.

Paper used per day (assuming 14 areas) is

 $14 \times 1 = 14 \text{ Sheets}$ 

Translating to a monthly number of (same as above)

 $14 \times 30 = 420$  sheets

This further equates to 420 x 12 = 5040 sheets annually!!



### **Solution**

- Adopted a simple and effective platform.
- Created a checklist for each area with a unique QR Code.
- Trained HK staff to scan and follow the checklist.
- Upload pictures in the checklist, post work and submit.



- Supervisor/Manager on shift checks on the work done through the app and validates the same.
- Dashboards are used to showcase work and inspections done.



# **Outcome**

#### Work:

- · Visibility on work done
- Improved accountability
- Recorded logs to check back at a later point in time
- Upskilled staff on using technology

#### Contribution to Mother Earth:

 Saved 5000+ sheets of paper annually
